About the Project

The Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) contractor is making drainage/utility improvements from east of the Howard Frankland Bridge to just east of Lois Avenue.

The work under this contract consists of building a drainage outfall system, box culverts, jacking and boring, storm sewers, retention ponds, and utility work. The construction, which is primarily on the south side of the interstate, is advance utility work for future I-275 widening in that part of the highway corridor.

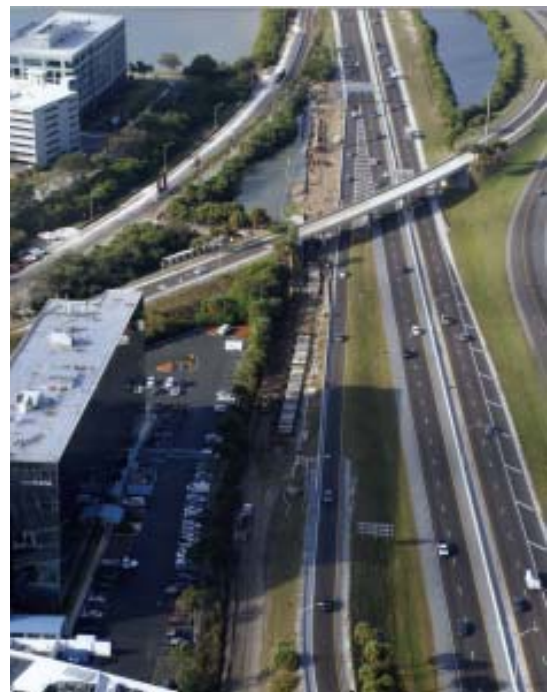
Lane Closure Hours
