About the Project The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be making capacity and safety improvements to the Interstate 275/Interstate 4 interchange in Hillsborough County, Florida. This will involve work on I-275 from the Hillsborough River north to Floribraska Avenue and on I-4 from east of 15th Street into the interchange.

As a result of these operational improvements, eight new bridges will be constructed, 18 existing bridges will be widened, and four lanes in each direction will tie into proposed four-lane projects on each end of the project (I-4 reconstruction from west of 14th Street to 50th Street and I-275 from Himes Avenue to the Hillsborough River).

#### **Improvement Highlights**

- Increase to 4 lanes in each direction.
- The Ashley Street entrance ramp will be extended -- continuing along I-275 to eastbound I-4.
- Downtown trips will be physically separated from through-trips by a local auxiliary exit ramp system.
- The flyover ramp from southbound I-275 to eastbound I-4 will be relocated to the right side of the highway to reduce weave movements.
- Shoulder-mounted 8-foot noise walls will be built adjacent to densely developed residential areas.
- Landscaping will be done in the infield area of the interchange and aesthetic treatments will be incorporated into the design of underpass areas and street ends.

**Traffic Flow** All existing travel lanes will be maintained during the day. This will allow maximum traffic flow during peak driving hours. The Ashley Street entrance ramp to northbound I-275/eastbound I-4 will have to be closed for approximately 200 days.

Night Work
Night construction is necessary in order to keep the lanes open during high use periods during the day. Lane closures/detours will occur between 10:00 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. as needed. While we will try to minimize all disturbances, area residents can expect some noise and lighted work areas at night.

Safety Along the Corridor To reduce delays caused by disabled vehicles and accidents, FDOT is providing **Road Rangers** to assist motorists (at no cost to the motorist). The Road Ranger wrecker patrols the I-275 / I-4 corridor around-the-clock, seven days-a-week.
