# Lane closures and detours on State Road 60 near TIA

TAMPA -- Lane closures or complete closures of eastbound and/or westbound State Road 60/ Memorial Highway may occur near the Spruce Street/Tampa International Airport (TIA) interchange as needed Friday through Sunday (October 17 - 26). Lane closures will be between 8:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.; complete closures will happen between 10:30 p.m. and 4:30 a.m.

DETOUR for EASTBOUND SR 60 CLOSURE: Traffic will be directed off at the Spruce Street/TIA exit, continue east on Spruce Street to Westshore Boulevard, then south on Westshore Boulevard to Cypress Street, northbound I-275, or Kennedy Boulevard. To access southbound I-275, continue south on Westshore Boulevard, then turn right onto Kennedy Boulevard, continue west and use the entrance ramp on the west side of Westshore Plaza.

DETOUR for WESTBOUND SR 60 CLOSURE: Northbound I-275 traffic will be directed off at Kennedy Boulevard (exit 39A). Southbound I-275 traffic will be directed to Exit 40A. All traffic will be directed north on Westshore Boulevard, then west on Spruce Street to westbound State Road 60 or Tampa International Airport.

Watch closely for lighted message signs alerting of the closures and to guide you to the detours.

# Eastbound SR 60 exit to Spruce Street / TIA closed at night

TAMPA -- The eastbound State Road 60/Memorial Highway exit to Spruce Street and Tampa International Airport may be closed between 10:30 p.m. and 4:30 a.m. Friday through Saturday (October 17 - 25) nights. Traffic will be routed to Kennedy Boulevard, then to northbound Westshore Boulevard, then to Spruce Street. Motorists going to TIA can enter via the westbound Spruce Street ramp. [This exit will not be closed at the same time when eastbound State Road 60 is closed; one or the other will be open. See previous item.]

## Ramp from Spruce Street to westbound SR 60 may be closed at night

TAMPA -- The westbound Spruce Street ramp to westbound State Road 60 may be closed between 10:30 p.m. and 4:30 a.m. Sunday through Saturday (October 19 - 25) nights. Traffic will be detoured south on Westshore Boulevard, then west on Kennedy Boulevard (westbound SR 60). This ramp will not be closed when the westbound State Road 60 detour is in place (see news "Lane closures and detours on State Road 60 near TIA").

## TIA exit road may be closed very early mornings

TAMPA -- Southbound George Bean Parkway (outbound roadway from Tampa International Airport) may be closed between 12:30 a.m. and 4:30 a.m. Saturday through Sunday (October 18 - 26) mornings. Traffic will be routed to the service roads, then out to Spruce Street at the O'Brien Street intersection. Depending on the destination, traffic will then be routed to I-275 or State Road 60 using local roads including Spruce Street, O'Brien Street, Cypress Street, and Westshore Boulevard. TAMPA -- One to two lanes will be closed on westbound Spruce Street from O'Brien Street to Tampa International Airport (TIA) from 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Saturday through Saturday (October 18 - 25) nights.

# Night detours and lane closures for SR 60 connection to Memorial/Veterans

TAMPA -- Traffic heading east or west on State Road 60 on the Courtney Campbell Parkway may be detoured at the traffic signal to northbound Memorial Highway/Veterans Expressway between 10:30 p.m. and 4:30 a.m. Saturday through Saturday (October 18 - 25) nights. One to two lanes may also be closed in that area on westbound State Road 60 from 8:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Friday through Saturday (October 17 - 25) nights .

DETOUR: Eastbound traffic will be directed east to the Spruce Street exit, where it will u-turn at O'Brien Street, then enter westbound State Road 60 and continue to Memorial Highway or the Veterans Expressway. Westbound traffic will be detoured north on Memorial Highway to Independence Parkway, then north on George Road to Memorial Highway, then east/south on Memorial to the ramp to westbound State Road 60.

# Monday night lane closures on I-275

ST. PETERSBURG/TAMPA -- Intermittent single-lane closures will take place between 8 p.m. Monday (October 20) and 4 a.m. Tuesday (October 21) in various locations in both directions of I-275 between 54th Avenue North (Exit 26) and the Howard Frankland Bridge and from Ashley Drive (Exit 44) to north of Bearss Avenue (Exit 53). Crews will be doing maintenance on overhead electronic signs.

# Northbound I-275 lane closures at night

TAMPA -- One to two lanes will be closed on northbound I-275 from Howard Avenue to Ashley Drive (Exit 44) from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (October 19 - 23) nights.

# Half of I-275 Exit 44 to be closed at night

TAMPA -- The northbound I-275 exit ramps to Ashley Drive and Scott Street may alternately close between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (October 19 - 23) nights.

Detour when Scott Street exit (left half of Exit 44) is closed: Traffic will be detoured to Ashley Drive (right ramp of Exit 44), then east on Cass Street, then north on Florida Avenue to Scott Street.

Detour when Ashley Drive exit (right half of Exit 44) is closed: Traffic will be detoured to Scott Street, then south on Tampa Street, then west on Tyler Street to Ashley Drive.

# Southbound I-275 Ashley ramps to be closed at night

TAMPA -- The southbound I-275 exit ramp to Ashley Drive and the Ashley Drive entrance ramp to southbound I-275 may be closed from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (October 19 - 23) nights.

Detours: for the southbound I-275 exit ramp closure: Use Exit 45A to Doyle Carlton Drive. Turn right at bottom of ramp onto Doyle Carlton, turn right onto Henderson Avenue, turn right onto Tampa Street and go south, turn right and go west on Tyler Street to Ashley Drive.

For northbound Ashley Drive entrance ramp closure to southbound I-275: Going north on Ashley Drive, turn right and go east on Cass Street, turn left and go north on Florida Avenue, turn left on Kay Street and go west to the I-275 entrance ramp at the Tampa Street/Kay Street intersection.

# Daytime lane closures on Himes Avenue

TAMPA -- The right lane will be closed on northbound Himes Avenue near the entrance ramp to northbound I-275 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday (October 20 - 24). Access to the entrance ramp will still be available.

# Day lane closures on Mac Dill Avenue

TAMPA -- One lane of both northbound and southbound Mac Dill Avenue may be closed from Arch Street to Green Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday (October 20 - 24).

# Armenia or Howard avenues to be closed south of I-275 at night

TAMPA — Either Armenia Avenue or Howard Avenue will be closed at I-275 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (October 19 - 23) nights. Armenia will be closed between Laurel and Arch streets; Howard will be closed from Arch Street to the northbound entrance ramp. All interstate ramps at the Armenia/Howard avenues interchange will remain open. However, traffic may be very congested in the Howard/Armenia area at I-275. In order to avoid delays, motorists are advised to consider alternate routes.

DETOUR for Armenia Avenue closure: Through-traffic on Armenia Avenue will be detoured west on Main Street, south on Mac Dill Avenue, then east on Cypress Street back to Armenia.

DETOUR for Howard Avenue closure: Howard Avenue traffic will be detoured east on Cypress Street, north on Rome Avenue, then west on Main Street back to Howard. Traffic wishing to access I-275 will continue west on Main Street, then south on Armenia Avenue. Motorists going south on I-275 will use the ramp at Green Street. Motorists accessing northbound I-275 will continue south on Armenia Avenue, then go east on Laurel Street to the northbound I-275 entrance ramp.
