project news: Interstate 4 through Ybor City

Lane closed on westbound I-4 at night week of January 28

TAMPA (Ybor City) -- The left lane (of 3 lanes) will be closed on westbound I-4 between 21st Street (Exit 1) and I-275 from 11:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Thursday nights (January 28-February 1).

15th Street closed under I-4

TAMPA (Ybor City) -- 15th Street will remain closed from south of 13th Avenue to north of 14th Avenue (under I-4) until further notice for construction activities. Traffic on this northbound road is being detoured to 14th Street, which has been turned into a 2-way traffic pattern in that area, then to 15th Avenue back to 15th Street.

Day lane closures on 22nd Street

TAMPA (Ybor City) -- The right lane (of 3 lanes) will be closed on 22nd Street from 12th Avenue to 14th Avenue between 9:30 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday (January 29-February 2).

26th Street to be closed under I-4 this week

TAMPA (Ybor City) -- 26th Street will be closed under I-4 (between Columbus Drive and the south side of I-4) from 6 a.m. Monday (January 29) to 6 p.m. Friday (February 2). Southbound 26th Street will be detoured east on Columbus Drive, then south on 34th Street, then west on 7th Avenue back to 26th Street. Northbound 26th Street will be detoured east on 7th Avenue, then north on 34th Street, then west on 18th Avenue, which curves over onto 17th Avenue and continues west back to 26th Street.

40th Street closed under I-4

TAMPA (Ybor City) -- 40th Street is closed under I-4 until approximately 5 p.m. Friday (February 2) for bridge and drainage work. 40th Street traffic is being detoured between Columbus Drive and 7th Avenue as follows: Northbound traffic goes west on 7th Avenue, then north on 34th Street, then east on Columbus Drive back to 40th Street. Southbound 40th Street traffic goes west on 18th Avenue, south on 34th Street, then east on 7th Avenue back to 40th Street.

MLK ramp to northbound I-75 closed weekend/nights

BRANDON -- The Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard (State Road 574) entrance ramp to northbound I-75 will be closed from 6 a.m. Saturday (January 27) to 6 a.m. Monday (January 29) and from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Thursday nights (January 29-February 1). Traffic will be detoured to southbound I-75, exit at State Road 60/Adamo Drive (Exit 257), then to the ramp to northbound I-75 from State Road 60. Motorists may also use U.S. Highway 301 or County Road 579 to I-4 to I-75.

State Road 60 ramp to northbound I-75 to be closed part of Wednesday night

BRANDON -- The State Road 60 entrance ramp to northbound I-75 will be closed between 8 p.m. and midnight on Wednesday (January 31). When the ramp is closed, traffic will be detoured to northbound U.S. Highway 301, then onto eastbound I-4 to the I-4 exit to I-75 (Exit 9). The MLK ramp closures (above) will not be in effect while this ramp is closed.

TAMPA -- Traffic on the ramp from westbound Spruce Street to George Bean Parkway (inbound roadway to Tampa International Airport) will be controlled by flag persons between 8:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Thursday and Friday nights (February 1 and 2). Expect brief delays.
