## **maintenance: Interstate 275 on the Sunshine Skyway Bridge**

### **Northbound lane closures on the Sunshine Skyway Bridge Monday night**

ST. PETERSBURG -- The left lane of northbound I-275 will be closed for maintenance at the high levels (near the towers) of the Sunshine Skyway Bridge between 7:30 p.m. and approximately midnight on Monday (May 24).

## **Project news: Northbound I-275 Connector to CR 296 / SR 686**

### **Night lane closures on I-275 north and south of Roosevelt Boulevard**

ST. PETERSBURG -- One lane will be closed on northbound and/or southbound I-275 between Gandy Boulevard (Exit 28) and Ulmerton Road (Exit 31) from 8 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (May 23 - 27) nights. Closures on northbound I-275 will not begin until two hours after Tampa Bay Rays' baseball games.

### **Eastbound 118th Avenue to be closed at night**

PINELLAS PARK -- Eastbound 118th Avenue (County Road 296) will be closed from 34th Street to 31st Court from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. Friday night, May 21 and Sunday through Thursday (May 23 - 27) nights. Traffic will be detoured north on 34th Street to Ulmerton Road (SR 688), east to eastbound Roosevelt Boulevard (SR 686), then south on 28th Street North back to 118th Avenue.

### **Southbound I-275 exit to CR 296 to be closed several early mornings**

ST. PETERSBURG -- The portion of southbound I-275 Exit 30 that connects to County Road 296 (118th Avenue) will be closed from 12:01 a.m. to 5:30 a.m. Monday through Wednesday (May 24 - 26) mornings.

DETOURS: Use Exit 31 and take Ulmerton Road (State Road 688) west to Roosevelt Boulevard (State Road 686), go east on Roosevelt, then turn right on 28th Street North and continue to County Road 296 / 118th Avenue. Another option is to exit at Exit 30, go west on Roosevelt, then turn left on 28th Street North and continue to County Road 296 / 118th Avenue.

**Project news: I-4 /Selmon Expressway Connector**

**Night lane closures on Adamo Drive**

TAMPA -- One lane may be closed in each direction of State Road 60 (Adamo Drive) between 34th Street and 50th Street from 7 p.m. to 4 a.m. Friday night, May 21 and Sunday through Friday (May 23 - 28) nights.

**Day lane closures on Durham Street**

TAMPA -- One lane will be closed for one block at a time on Durham Street between 26th Street and 30th Street between 7 a.m. and 5:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday (May 24 - 29) for water line work. Residential traffic will be maintained by flaggers and access will be maintained to driveways. These closures are expected Mondays through Saturdays throughout the months of May and June.

**Project news: I-75 Deck Repairs over Broadway and CSX Tracks**

**Lanes closed at night on southbound I-75 at MLK**

BRANDON -- One to two lanes will be closed on southbound I-75 from south of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. (State Road 574, Exit 260) for about one mile from 7:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. Friday through Sunday (May 21 - 23) nights. Friday night's closures will not begin until 9 p.m.

**Lanes closed at night on northbound I-75 south of MLK**

BRANDON -- One to two lanes will be closed on northbound I-75 south of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. (State Road 574, Exit 260A/B) from 7:30 p.m. to 6 a.m. Tuesday through Thursday (May 25 - 27) nights.

**Project news: I-75/I-275 Exit Ramps to State Road 56**

**Night lane closures and traffic shifts on I-75 at I-275**

NEW TAMPA -- Traffic will be reduced to a single lane and may be routed to a different alignment onto temporary pavement on northbound and southbound I-75 from south of I-275 to State Road 56 (Exit 275) from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Friday through Thursday (May 21 - 27) nights. The speed limit will also be reduced to 50 MPH during these lane closures. *Motorists can expect delays in both directions of I-75 these nights.*

**Night lane closures on I-275 approaching I-75**

NEW TAMPA -- The right lane will be closed on northbound I-275 from just south of I-75 to the interchange at I-75 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Friday through Thursday (May 21 - 27) nights.

**Project news: Interstate 75 Interchange at County Road 54**

**CR 54 to be closed under I-75 at night**

WESLEY CHAPEL -- County Road 54 will be closed under I-75 between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Friday through Wednesday (May 21 - 26) nights. All ramps will be open, but no traffic will be able to cross under I-75. DETOUR: Local traffic will be detoured using State Road 54, County Road 54, Bruce B. Downs Boulevard, and the I-75 interchange at State Road 56.

**Lane closures at night on I-75 at CR 54**

WESLEY CHAPEL -- One lane will be closed on northbound and southbound I-75 from south of County Road 54 (Exit 279) to north of the interchange between 8 p.m. and 5 a.m. Friday night, May 21 and Sunday through Wednesday (May 23 - 26) nights.

**Project news: Interstate 75 from County Road 54 to Hernando County line**

**Night lane closures on I-75 in northern Pasco County**

PASCO COUNTY -- One lane will be closed for paving in either direction of I-75 in Pasco County in various places between County Road 54 (Exit 279) and the Pasco/Hernando counties line between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (May 23 - 27) nights.

**Project news: Interstate 75 from Pasco / Hernando County line to Lockhart Road**

**Night lane closures on I-75 in southern Hernando County**

HERNANDO COUNTY -- One lane will be closed on northbound and/or southbound I-75 in various locations in Hernando County between the Pasco/Hernando counties line and Lockhart Road between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (May 23 - 27) nights.
