maintenance: I-275 on the Sunshine Skyway Bridge

Monday night lane closures on Skyway Bridge

ST. PETERSBURG -- The right lane will be closed in various locations on northbound and southbound I-275 on the Sunshine Skyway Bridge from 8 p.m. Monday (August 25) to 4 a.m. Tuesday (August 26). Crews will be doing maintenance work on cameras.

maintenance: Interstate 275

Night lane closure on southbound I-275 between I-375 and I-175

ST. PETERSBURG -- The left lane will be closed on southbound I-275 between I-375 (Exit 23A) and I-175 (Exit 22) from 9 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Monday through Wednesday (August 25 - 27) nights. Crews will be installing overhead signs.

Day lane closures on northbound I-275 on Howard Frankland Bridge

ST. PETERSBURG/TAMPA -- The right lane of northbound I-275 on the Howard Frankland Bridge will be closed between 10:30 a.m. and 3 p.m. Monday through Friday (August 25 - 29). The closure will begin on the Pinellas County side of the bridge and end in Hillsborough County.

Monday night lane closures on I-275

TAMPA -- Intermittent lane closures will take place between 8 p.m. Monday (August 25) and 4 a.m. Tuesday (August 26) in both directions of I-275 between 54th Avenue North (Exit 26) and the Howard Frankland Bridge and from Ashley Drive (Exit 44) to north of Bearss Avenue (Exit 53). Crews will be doing maintenance on overhead electronic signs.

project news: I-275 Box Culvert from Howard Frankland Bridge to Lois Ave.

Lane closed at night on I-275 exit to Kennedy

TAMPA -- One of two lanes will be closed on the northbound I-275 exit ramp to Kennedy Boulevard (Exit 39A) from 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Tuesday (August 24 - 26) nights.

project news: Northbound I-275 from Himes Avenue to the Hillsborough River

Northbound I-275 lane closures at night

TAMPA -- One to two lanes will be closed on northbound I-275 from Howard Avenue to Ashley Drive (Exit 44) between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (August 24 - 28) nights.

Half of I-275 Exit 44 to be closed at night

TAMPA -- The northbound I-275 exit ramps to Ashley Drive and Scott Street will alternately close between 11 p.m. and 4 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (August 24 - 28) nights.

Detour when Scott Street exit (left half of Exit 44) is closed: Traffic will be detoured to Ashley Drive (right ramp of Exit 44), then east on Cass Street, then north on Florida Avenue to Scott Street.

Detour when Ashley Drive exit (right half of Exit 44) is closed: Traffic will be detoured to Scott Street, then south on Tampa Street, then west on Tyler Street to Ashley Drive.

Daytime lane closures on Himes Avenue

TAMPA -- The right lane will be closed on northbound Himes Avenue near the entrance ramp to northbound I-275 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday (August 25 - 29). Access to the entrance ramp will still be available.

Mac Dill Avenue to be closed at I-275 one night

TAMPA -- Mac Dill Avenue will be closed from Green Street to La Salle Street from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. one night during the week of August 24 - 28 for a concrete deck pour. [At the time of this release, it was not yet known which night the pour would take place.] DETOUR: Traffic will be detoured using Main and Cypress streets, and Howard (northbound) and Armenia (southbound) avenues.

Day lane closures on Mac Dill Avenue

TAMPA -- One lane of both northbound and southbound Mac Dill Avenue may be closed from La Salle Street to Green Street from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday through Friday (August 25 - 29).

Doyle Carlton Drive to be closed periodically under I-275

TAMPA -- Doyle Carlton Drive may periodically be closed to traffic under I-275 from 7 p.m. to 4 p.m. Sunday through Friday (August 24 - 29). No closures will take place between 4 p.m. and 7 p.m. Traffic will be detoured as follows:

Northbound: East on Laurel Street, north on Ashley Drive, east on Scott Street, north on Franklin Street, then west on Henderson Avenue to Doyle Carlton.

Southbound: East on Henderson Avenue, south on Tampa Street, then west on Laurel Street.

Closures on Green and Laurel streets

TAMPA -- Green Street remains closed from Laurel Street to North Boulevard until approximately early September. Local access to Presbyterian Village will be maintained. Laurel Street has been turned into two-way traffic between Green Street and North Boulevard for the detour.

maintenance: Interstate 4

Monday night lane closures on I-4

TAMPA -- Brief, intermittent lane closures will take place on I-4 in various locations in both directions from east of 50th Street (Exit 3) to east of County Road 579 (Exit 10) between 8 p.m. Monday (August 25) and 4 a.m. Tuesday (August 26). Crews will be working on overhead message signs.

Night lane closures on I-4 in Plant City

PLANT CITY -- The right lane may be closed on eastbound or westbound I-4 between Park Road (Exit 22) and County Line Road (Exit 25) between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. Monday through Thursday (August 25 - 28) nights.

project news: I-75 at Bruce B. Downs (County Road 581) Flyover

Night lane closures on southbound I-75 south of Bruce B. Downs

NEW TAMPA -- One lane will be closed on southbound I-75 from Bruce B. Downs Boulevard (County Road 581, Exit 270) to the Hillsborough River (about 3 miles south of Bruce B. Downs) from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (August 24 - 28) nights.

project news: Tampa Airport Interchanges (State Road 60)

Lane to reopen on eastbound State Road 60 ramp to southbound Memorial

TAMPA -- The left lane on the eastbound State Road 60 ramp from the Courtney Campbell Parkway to southbound Memorial Highway is scheduled to reopen on Thursday (August 28). It has been closed around-the-clock since Monday morning (August 18).

This has resulted in a 1/4 mile shorter merge area from where this ramp connects to southbound Memorial Highway/Veterans Expressway. Motorists should remain alert to these changed conditions approaching the exit to Spruce Street and Tampa International Airport.

Lane closures and detours on State Road 60 near TIA

TAMPA -- Lane closures or complete closures of eastbound and/or westbound State Road 60/Memorial Highway may occur near the Spruce Street/Tampa International Airport (TIA) exit as needed Saturday through Saturday morning (August 24 - 30). Lane closures will occur between 8:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m.; complete closures will happen between 12 a.m. and 4 a.m.

DETOUR for EASTBOUND SR 60 CLOSURE: All traffic will be directed off at the Spruce Street/TIA exit. Traffic can continue east on Spruce Street to Westshore Boulevard, then south on Westshore Boulevard to Cypress Street, northbound I-275, or Kennedy Boulevard. To access southbound I-275, continue south on Westshore Boulevard, then turn right onto Kennedy Boulevard, continue west and use the entrance ramp on the west side of Westshore Plaza.

DETOUR for WESTBOUND SR 60 CLOSURE: Northbound I-275 traffic will be directed off at Kennedy Boulevard (exit 39A). Southbound I-275 traffic will be directed to Exit 40A. All traffic will be directed north on Westshore Boulevard, then west on Spruce Street to westbound State Road 60 or Tampa International Airport.

Watch closely for lighted message signs on I-275 and State Road 60 that will state which directions are closed and guide you to the detour routes. You may also find specific night closings on myTBI.com as they are scheduled.

Night detours for SR 60 connection to Memorial / Veterans

TAMPA -- Traffic heading east or west on State Road 60 on the Courtney Campbell Parkway may be detoured at the traffic signal to northbound Memorial Highway/Veterans Expressway from 12 to 4 a.m. Saturday through Friday (August 23 - 29) mornings.

DETOURS: Eastbound traffic will be directed east to the Spruce Street exit, where it will u-turn at O'Brien Street, then enter westbound State Road 60 and continue to Memorial Highway or the Veterans Expressway.

Westbound traffic will be detoured north to Independence Parkway, then north on George Street, then onto southbound Memorial Highway/Veterans Expressway to the ramp to westbound State Road 60 at the Courtney Campbell.

Eastbound SR 60 exit to Spruce Street / TIA closed early mornings

TAMPA -- The eastbound State Road 60/Memorial Highway exit to Spruce Street and Tampa International Airport may be closed between 12:01 a.m. and 4 a.m. Saturday through Friday (August 23 - 29) mornings. Traffic will be routed to Kennedy Boulevard, then to northbound Westshore Boulevard, then to Spruce Street. Motorists going to TIA can enter via the westbound Spruce Street ramp.

[This exit will not be closed at the same time when eastbound State Road 60 is closed; one or the other will be open. See item above.]

Lanes closed at night on southbound Memorial / eastbound SR 60

TAMPA -- One to two lanes will be closed on southbound Memorial Highway / eastbound State Road 60 just south of the Courtney Campbell Parkway between 8:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (August 24 - 28) nights.

Night lane closures on SR 60 on east end of Courtney Campbell

TAMPA -- One to two lanes will be closed on eastbound and westbound State Road 60 on the east end of the Courtney Campbell Parkway between Bayport Drive and Memorial Highway between 8:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (August 24 - 28) nights.
