TAMPA -- One of two lanes may be closed on Doyle Carlton Drive under I-275 between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. Monday through Friday (September 10-14). Traffic will be controlled by flag persons.

Night lane closures on westbound I-4

TAMPA (Ybor City) -- Two of four lanes will be closed on westbound I-4 from 50th Street to east of I-275 between 11:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Sunday through Thursday (Sept. 9-13) nights.

Lane closures and traffic pacing on eastbound I-4 two nights

TAMPA (Ybor City)—Three of four lanes will be closed on eastbound I-4 from I-275 to east of 22nd Street between 11:30 p.m. and 5:30 a.m. Monday and Tuesday (September 10 and 11) nights. Traffic will also be slowed and paced by law enforcement officers at least two times Tuesday night into Wednesday morning on northbound I-275 from Dale Mabry Highway (Exit 41A) onto eastbound I-4 to east of 22nd Street as crews erect a sign structure across the interstate. Motorists can expect delays up to 30 minutes and may want to choose an alternate route.

Traffic will be detoured to westbound I-4 (Exit 261), then to U.S. 301 (Exit 7). Motorists can then head south on U.S. 301 to MLK.
